To preserve the tradition, comfort, and atmosphere of Indian Hills Country Club, all members and guests are expected to adhere to the following dress standards while enjoying our dining and social facilities.

General Club Standards

- Hats and caps are not permitted in indoor dining areas
- Members are responsible for the attire of their guests
- Management reserves the right to determine the appropriateness of any attire

The cooperation of members and their guests is appreciated in maintaining the traditions and standards of Indian Hills Country Club.

Overlook Restaurant Dinner Service

(Dining Room, Bar and Patio)

The Overlook Restaurant maintains a **refined club casual** atmosphere.

Gentlemen

- Collared shirts (golf shirts, button-downs, or dress shirts) are required
- Slacks, chinos, or tailored shorts permitted or formal denim
- Jackets are encouraged for evening dining but not required
- Closed-toe shoes or dress sandals are preferred

Ladies

- Dresses, skirts, tailored shorts, slacks or formal denim
- Blouses, sweaters, or fashionable tops
- Dress sandals, flats, or appropriate casual footwear

Not Permitted

- Athletic wear at dinner (gym shorts, sweatpants, workout tanks)
- Denim that is torn or distressed
- Swimwear
- T-shirts with offensive or inappropriate graphics
- Bare feet

Bar & Patio Notes

The bar and patio follow the same dress code as the dining room, with slightly more relaxed expectations during daytime hours. Golf attire is welcome at all times provided it is neat and in good condition.

19th Hole

(Casual Dining)

The 19th Hole offers a more relaxed setting; however, proper golf and casual attire remains expected.

Appropriate Attire

- Collared shirts, appropriate golf, tennis or workout attire
- Slacks, chinos, or neat denim
- Bermuda-length shorts
- Golf shoes, athletic shoes, or casual footwear

Not Permitted

- Tank tops (men), cut-offs
- Swimwear
- Clothing that is torn, soiled, or displays offensive language or imagery
- Bare feet
